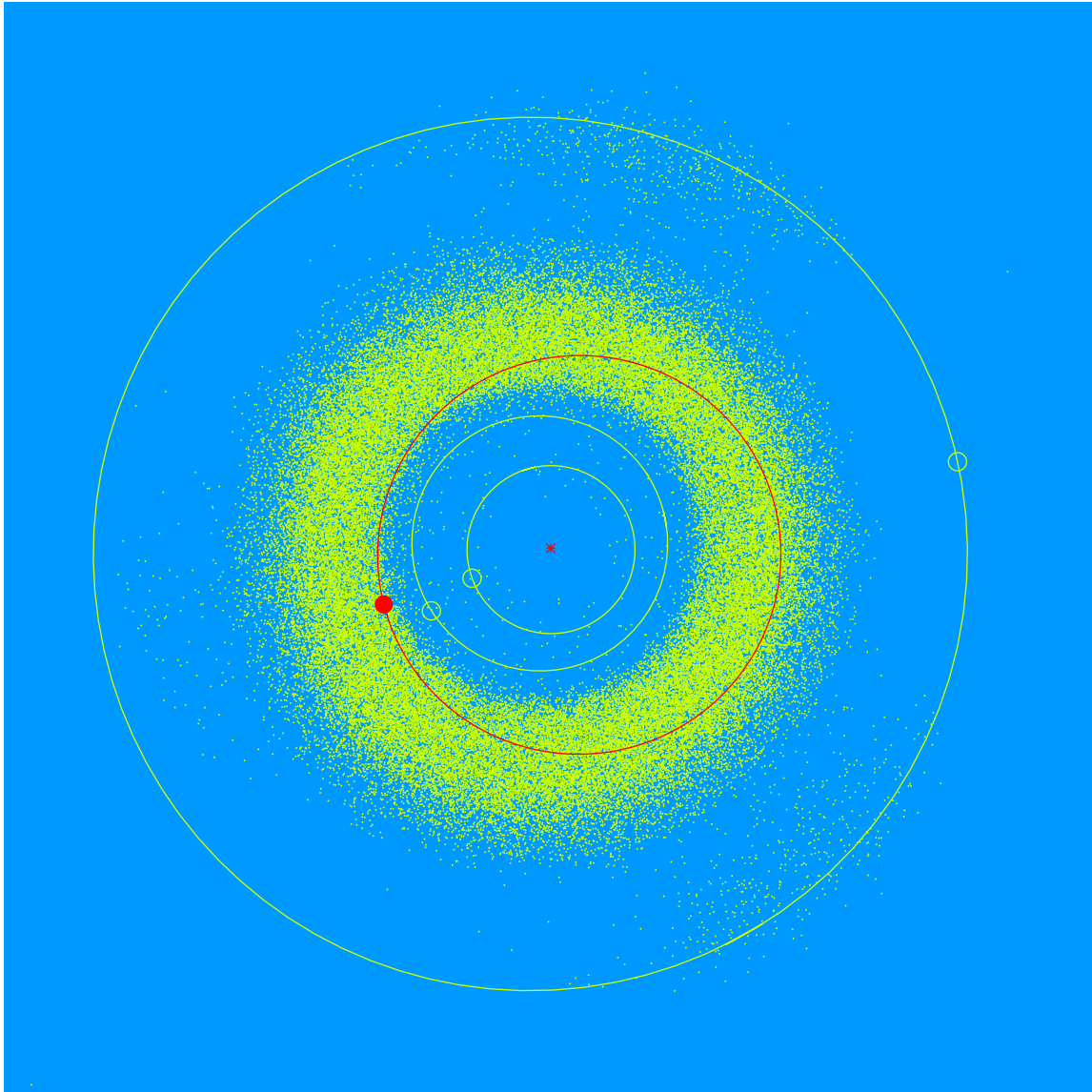


(31647) Beauwigman = 1999 GY₅₁

Discovered 1999 Apr. 11 by the Lowell Observatory Near-Earth Object Search at the Anderson Mesa Station.

Beau C. Wigman (b. 1979) is an American Facilities and Mechanical Technician at Lowell Observatory.
