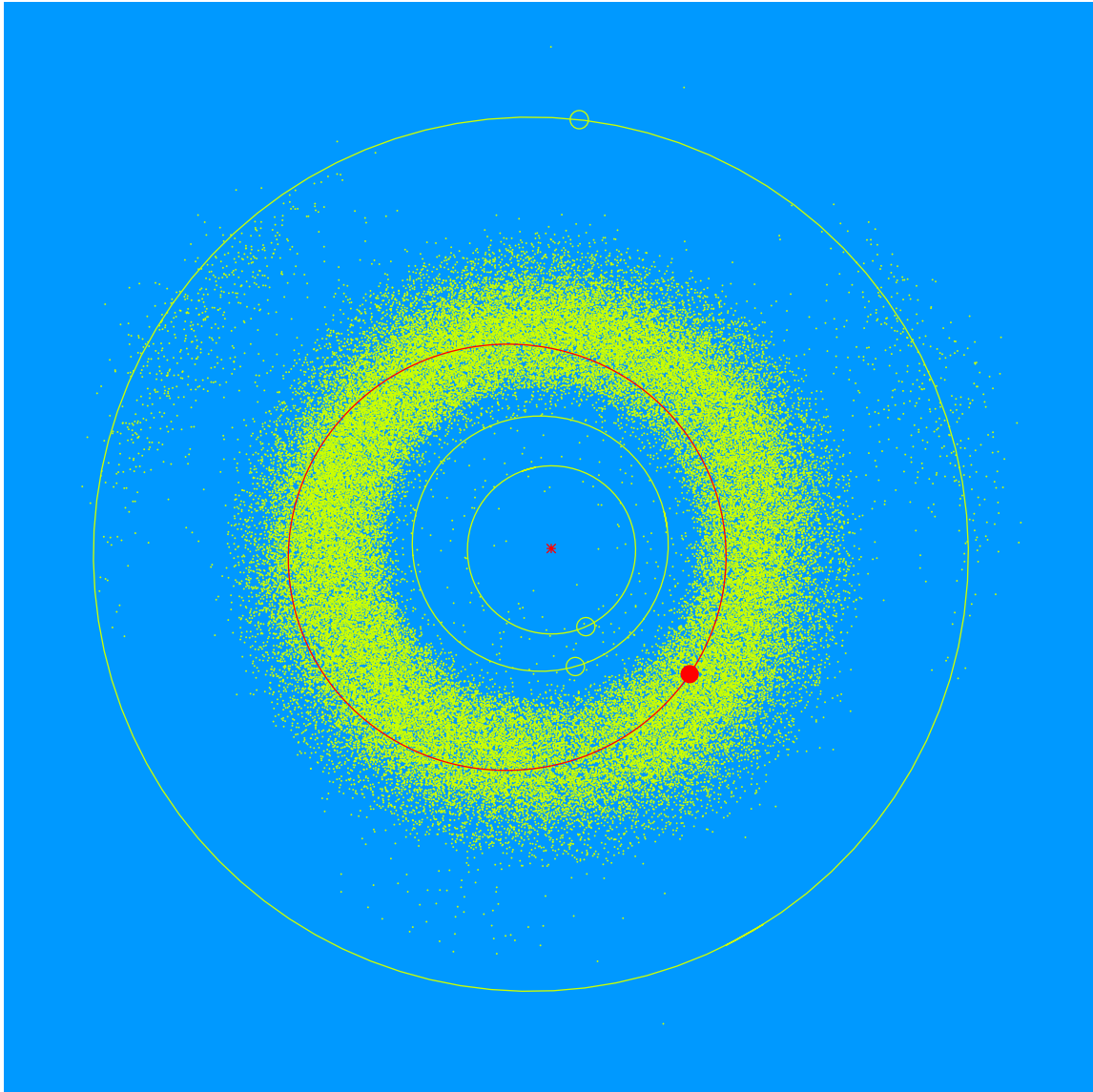


(30559) Cyrusavery = 2001 OG₆₈ Discovered 2001 July 16 by the Lowell Observatory Near-Earth Object Search at the Anderson Mesa Station.

Cyrus Avery (1871-1963) was an American oilman and highway commissioner who helped create U.S. Route 66 while serving on the federal board that developed the United States highway system. He later championed the formation of the U.S. Highway 66 Association to pave and promote the road. His leadership earned him the enduring title "Father of Route 66".
