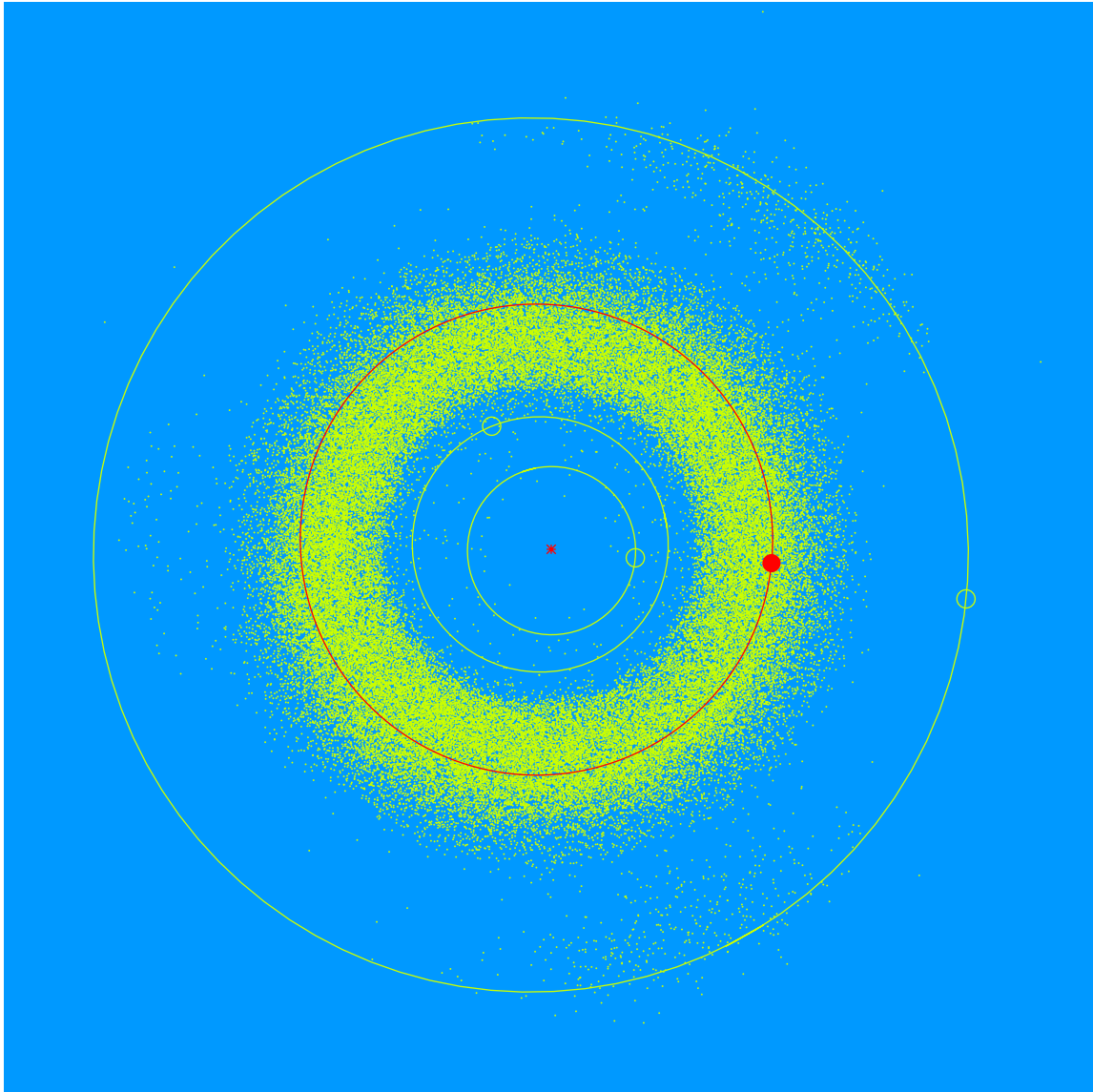


(28116) Drewbarringer = 1998 SP₅₆

Discovered 1998 Sep. 17 by the Lowell Observatory Near-Earth Object Search at the Anderson Mesa Station.

Drew Barringer (b. 1946) is the grandson of Daniel Barringer who provided proof that Meteor Crater was formed by the impact of a large meteorite. Drew has been a longtime active member of Lowell Observatory's Advisory Board and serves on the Executive Committee.
