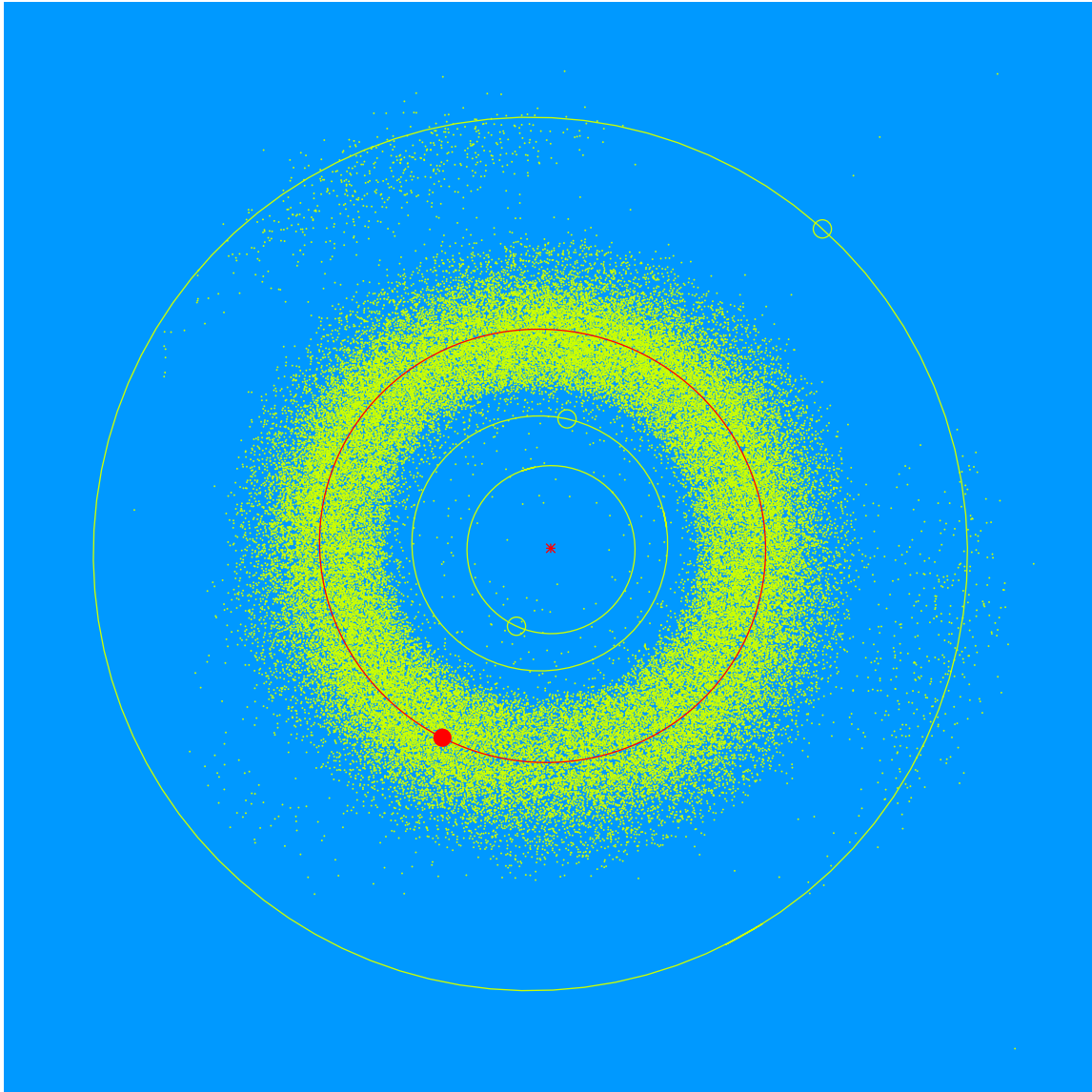


(28890) Gabaldon = 2000 KY₆₅

Discovered 2000 May 27 by the Lowell Observatory Near-Earth Object Search at the Anderson Mesa Station.
