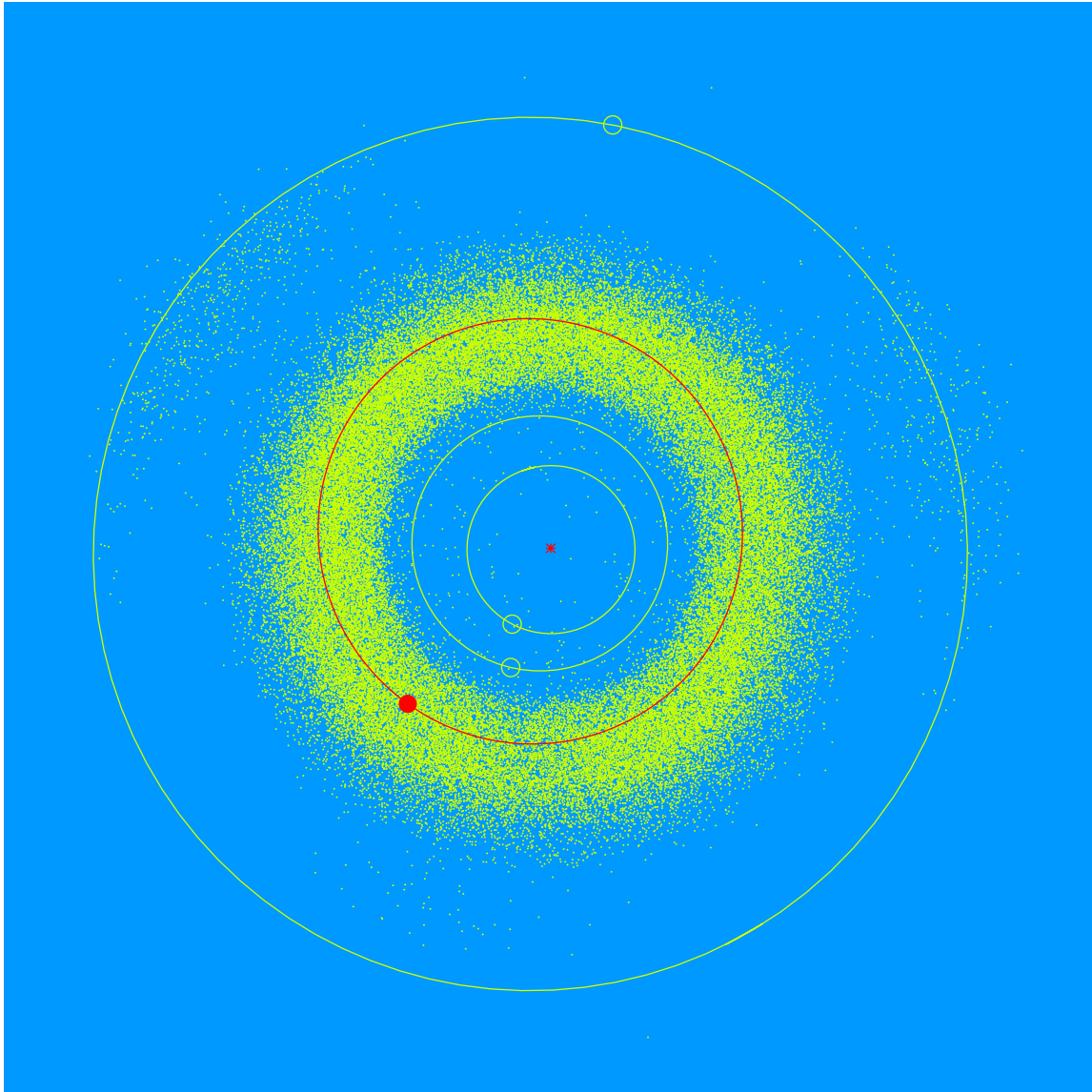


(27622) Richardbaker = 2001 KS₇₁

Discovered 2001 May 24 by the Lowell Observatory Near-Earth Object Search at the Anderson Mesa Station.
