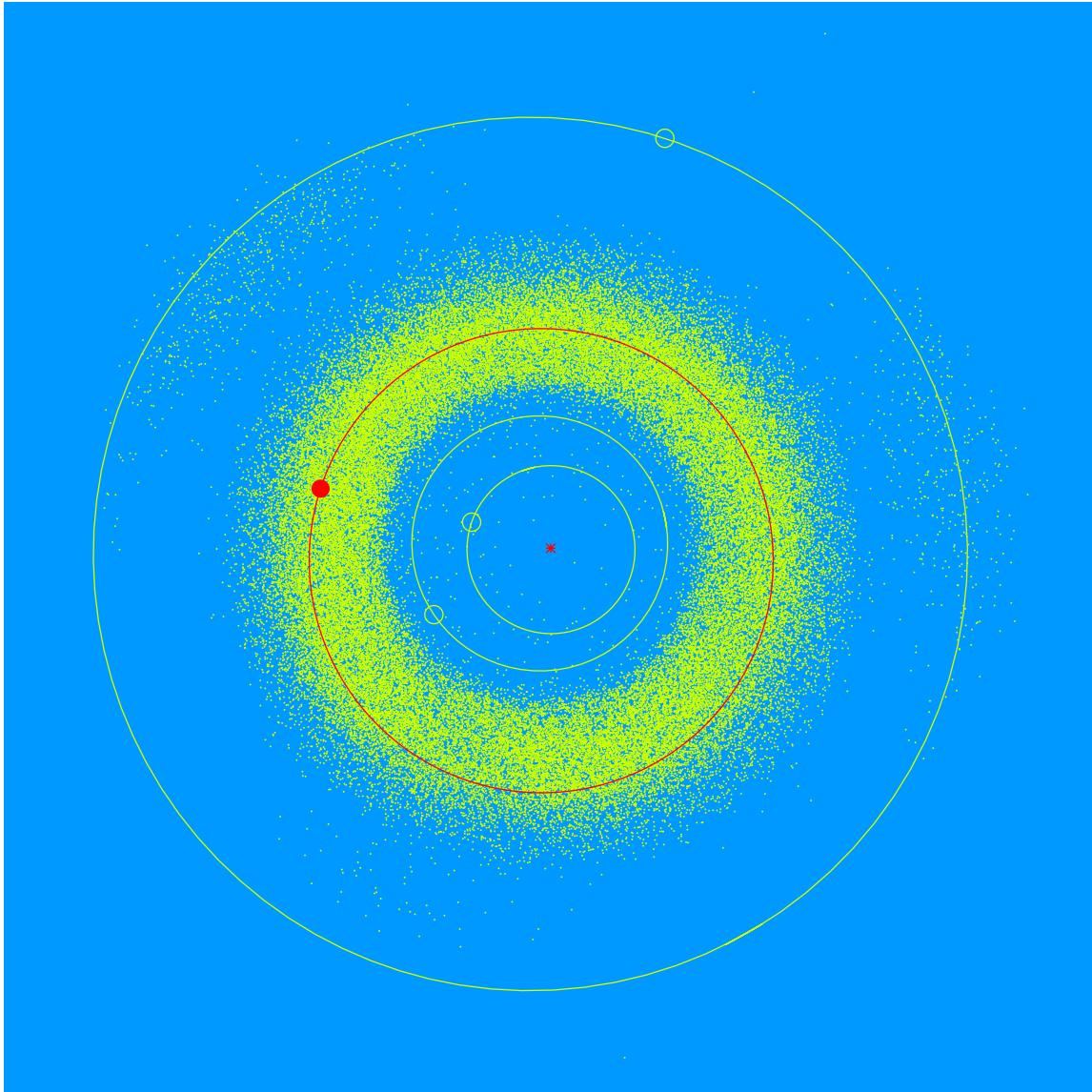


(46076) Robertschottland = 2001 EH₄
